**MOTION** L. Colwell to approve the minutes of the above-listed meetings as presented.  
Second S. Evans. Carried unanimously.

*Appointments: Cemetery Committee and Recreation Committee*

H. Tirrell presented the following people for appointments:

- Grant Mudge to fill Cemetery Committee vacancy – no term limit
- Marie-Christine Perry to fill Recreation Committee vacancy – term expires 7/31/30
- Jessica Listorti to fill Recreation Committee alternate vacancy – term expires 7/31/31

**MOTION** S. Evans to appoint all those presented. Second L. Colwell. Carried unanimously.

*Transfer Station and Tobey Pond Pricing*

Discussion centered on pricing for tire disposal. Residents are currently charged \$5.00 for small tires and \$15.00 for large tires. These are the prices charged by the CRM CO. who picks up the tires in addition to a fuel surcharge. Discussion regarding increasing the price to cover the fuel surcharge.

Transfer Station and Tobey Pond sticker pricing was discussed and will remain at the current pricing but are subject to change depending on the outcome of the Northwest Resource Recovery Authority (NRRA) plan.

**MOTION** S. Evans to increase the small tire charge to \$6.00 per tire. Second L. Colwell.  
Carried unanimously.

**MOTION** S. Evans to keep Transfer Station and Tobey Pond sticker pricing at the current rate.  
Second L. Colwell. Carried unanimously.

*Selectman's Report*

- Fire House – The contractors have been back at work since 3/23/26 and are working on preparation for the foundation. A site meeting will be held tomorrow.
- Mountain Road Bridge – The bridge will be closed beginning Monday, April 6<sup>th</sup>. Signage is posted for the detour and H. Tirrell notified the school, fire department and ambulance.
- Special Town Meeting to be held on Monday, April 6<sup>th</sup>
- Inland/Wetlands Meeting will include proposals for the Smith Road Bridge and Old Goshen Road Bridge

*Selectman's Report (continued)*

- Wall Project – The contractors are back at work and a site meeting will be held tomorrow. The winter delay should not affect the completion date.
- H. Tirrell traveled to the Capitol today to offer testimony in support of Senate Bill 521 to convey the Torrington Transfer Station to the Northwest Resource Recovery Authority (NRRA). A number of elected officials from the region provided testimony either written or in person. A vote will take place on Monday, 4/6/26 to move the bill to the next step. Northwest Hill Council of Governments (NHCOG) is planning to hire a consultant to assist in the process.
- Transfer Station – H. Tirrell reached out to Salisbury and Sharon regarding the management of their Transfer Station. They would welcome a visit from a Norfolk representative.
- Discussion was held regarding future management and possible changes for the Norfolk Transfer Station.
