

FEE STRUCTURE

Annual Sticker

\$100 first vehicle

\$80 second vehicle

Vehicles MUST be registered at the same address in order to qualify for discount.

Bulky Waste

Average load \$40 (2 tkts)

Attendant will determine the number of tickets (cost) per load!

Number of tickets charged is based on a calculation of cubic area & contents of load as assessed by the attendant. The price list below is a general range to help the resident estimate the load prior to dumping. It is NOT to be seen as a cap or limit on tickets assessed. The attendant is authorized to accept or reject a load and/or assess tickets based on current conditions at the Transfer Station and any criteria set forth by the haulage firms that dispose of those materials.

Passenger car	1-2 ticket
1/2 ton pickup	2-3 tickets
1 ton pickup	2-4 tickets
1 ton dump truck	3-5 tickets
Trailers & roll offs	See Attendant

Types of materials accepted:

All lumber products, construction/demolition debris, sheet rock & shingles, furniture, children's plastic yard toys, ceramics, insulation, anything that can't be burned.

Types of materials not accepted:

Bricks, concrete, stone, asphalt, propane tanks, stumps & logs.

The lists of accepted/not accepted materials are a guideline and not exhaustive or complete. Please check with the attendant for most up-to-date lists.

Tires (Off rim only)

Passenger tires \$6.00 per tire

20" and over \$17.00 per tire

Tractor Tires \$50.00 per tire

Commercial Truck Tires \$50.00 per tire

REMINDERS

Stickers by JULY 1.

Stickers **MUST** be **PERMANENTLY** affixed to the **LOWER** corner of the windshield on the **DRIVER'S** side.

This brochure contains the most relevant information but is not a complete listing of Transfer Station Rules & Regulations. For clarification please see the attendant.

Sort trash from recyclables.

Flatten ALL cardboard & sort/separate recyclables BEFORE you arrive at the transfer station.

All refrigerators must be cleaned out & doors removed prior to disposal

STOP at the top of the ramp **BEFORE** you enter the shed.

Only **3 vehicles** in the unloading area inside the shed at one time.

Turn off your car while unloading.

Hazardous Waste may be disposed of 2x a year. Please call the Selectman's Office 860-542-5829

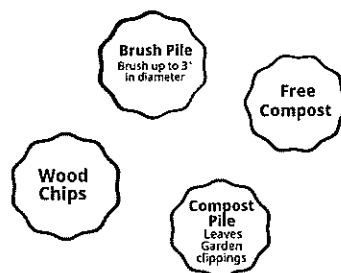

Municipal Solid Waste (MSW)

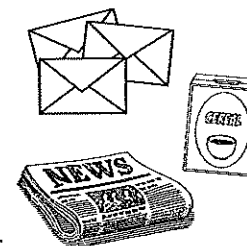
Household Rubbish/Garbage (must be bagged), non-recyclable glass, latex paint cans (paint **MUST** be dried), other items as approved by the attendant.

Please note: rules for the Transfer Station have changed due to a change in how our MSW & bulky waste is now handled. It is important to understand that just because you used to do deposit a certain way doesn't mean that is still how it's done. Always check with the attendant if you have a question.

Paper & Paper Products

NO pizza boxes or shredded paper!
They go in the trash.
