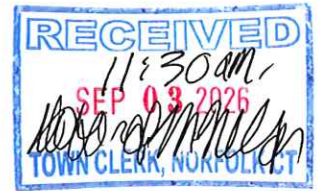


TOWN OF NORFOLK
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 2, 2026



A Special Town Meeting of the electors and citizens qualified to vote in the Town of Norfolk was held at Botelle Elementary School, 128 Greenwoods Rd E, Norfolk, Connecticut 06058, on Wednesday, September 2, 2026. The meeting was called to order by Deborah M. Nelson, Town Clerk, at 7:00 p.m.

Sandy Evans made a motion to nominate Richard Byrne to serve as moderator and John DeShazo seconded the motion. Since no further nominations were made, the Town Clerk closed the nominations. A voice vote was taken, and Richard Byrne was elected unanimously. Richard Byrne read the warning aloud.

ITEM 1.

To consider and act upon a resolution to appropriate for the acquisition of a new pumper truck for use by the Norfolk Volunteer Fire Department no more than \$1,252,490.00 and to authorize an initial deposit of \$260,000 from the Fire Truck Fund.

In response to an inquiry from Susan MacEachron, Henry Tirrell, First Selectman, explained where future funding for the fire truck would come from.

ITEM 2.

To consider and act upon a resolution to appropriate an additional \$125,000 for the construction of the new fire house from the \$10,400,000 approved at the Special Town Meeting held on October 6, 2025, to \$10,525,000. With no change to the amount to be borrowed for the project from the \$4,000,000 approved at the Special Town Meeting held on October 6, 2025.

In response to a question from Susan MacEachron, Michael Sconyers gave clarification to funding allocated for the fire house project.

Motion proposed by Paul Padua
Motion carried unanimously.

ITEM 3.

Shall the Town of Norfolk amend Section 84-1.A of the Town Ordinance pertaining to Inland Wetlands Commission fees.

Hartley Mead explained the need for changes to the fee schedule. Stacey, Sefcik, ZEO, added further explanation to the proposed changes.

Motion proposed by Ayreslea Denny
Motion carried unanimously.

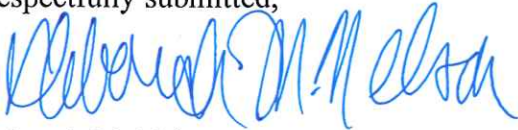
